Enrollment Fee (one time)	<b>\$130</b>	\$395	Official evaluation of transferred credits, academic advisement and academic program planning for first year. The enrollment fee reverts to the standard rate if student does not complete a minimum of twelve (12) Excelsior College course credits prior to completion of their degree.
Tuition (per credit)	<b>\$305</b>	\$355	Participation in academic coursework.
Student Services Annual Fee (paid on an annual basis with the first annual fee charged one year after enrollment)	<b>\$0</b> <b>Provided six</b> <b>Excelsior course</b> <b>credits taken in one</b> <b>year</b>	\$440	Library services, academic advising and academic program planning. No Student Services Annual Fee will be charged provided student completes a minimum of six (6) Excelsior College course credits within the one-year period. If the student does not complete six (6) Excelsior College course credits within the one-year period, the Student Service Annual Fee will be \$225.00 for the subsequent year.
Graduation Fee (one time)	<b>\$130</b> <b>Provided 12</b> <b>Excelsior course</b> <b>credits taken prior</b> <b>to degree</b> <b>completion</b>	\$495	Final review and processing of student files for conferring of degree and issuance of diploma. The Graduation Fee reverts to the Standard Rate if the student does not complete a minimum of twelve (12) Excelsior College course credits prior to completion of their degree program. In the event the Graduation Fee reverts to the Standard Rate, this fee will be reduced by \$15 per academic credit for each undergraduate Excelsior College course successfully completed. This fee reduction does not apply to academic credits transferred to Excelsior College.
