

COMMON QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS REGARDING MEMBERSHIP

How do I renew on line?

Please click on this link: <http://emem.vfw.org/> and 'Register' for an eMembership account. You create your own password for your account. You must have your VFW member number to register. Your member number is: _____.

After you register, a PIN number will be emailed to you. After you receive the PIN number, go to <http://emem.vfw.org/> and click on "Secure Sign In." Enter the email and password that you created when registering, then click "Sign In." Next you will be prompted to enter your PIN number. Enter the PIN number you received in the email, this will give you access to eMembership Tools. Now you can manage your membership online. You will not need the PIN number again.

The tabs on this screen allow you to manage your membership. "Renew Membership" will let you renew on an annual basis. "Convert to Life Membership" will walk you through becoming a life member.

How do I join a post?

Please click on this link: <https://emem.vfw.org/findpost.aspx>. Enter your ZIP code (or where you plan to live when you return to the United States). You may want to change the search radius to greater than 5 miles. If there's no phone number, let us know, and we'll try to put you in touch with the commander or Adjutant/Quartermaster. You must contact the post to join. You cannot transfer into a post on-line.
