



WHAT? Game hunt (Deer, Bear, Quail, Turkey, Grouse) for up to seven (7) combat disabled OIF/OEF veterans living in California, plus aides, if required.

WHO? The event is being hosted by Fulton Land and Livestock, L. L. C. with the help of the Humboldt County Cattleman's Association and members of VFW District 21 and the Department of California VFW.

WHERE? In the mountains and rolling hills of Humboldt County of Northern California on a 17,000 acre ranch located between the Pacific Ocean and the Town of Ruth; between the elevations of 1,000 to 5,000 feet. Guests will be housed in a 2,000 Square foot ranch house with ADA bathrooms and access. The house has a very large covered deck with beautiful sweeping views and landscaping.

WHEN? October 14, 15, 16, 17, 2010, the last week of deer season. Plan to arrive anytime on October 14 and depart anytime October 17. You will be hunting on the 15th and 16th. It is a cool time of year in Humboldt County with sunny days.

Local transportation (ATV's, 4 WD Trucks, etc) will be provided along with hunting guides.

Guests should be prepared to provide their own firearms, appropriate hunting license(s) and transportation to Humboldt County. Grants may be available to assist with travel.

There will be approximately 25 people present at this event, and Cattleman's Association will provide all meals, gas, transportation to the ranch and back.
